


Ellevate Squads Code of Conduct

For Squad Mods: How to Setup Your Squad

- Setup the Zoom meeting URL: We recommend doing this shortly after you receive the email confirmation that your Squad is activated
- 2. Say "Hello" in the Group Conversation: Get everyone comfortable by saying "hello" and sharing a little bit about what you expect from the Squads experience. The more you model communication early on, the easier it will be to keep the conversation going.
- 3. Bookmark the Meeting Agenda Templates: In our Squad Support Center, we have templates to help you conduct each 30 minute Squad meeting. Bookmark these so that you can save time and make sure each meeting is run efficiently.

The Kickoff Meeting

- The Kickoff Meeting is the first of 12 Squad meetings.
- Before the scheduled meeting time, everybody should have introduced themselves in the Group Conversation and filled out the Goals Worksheet
- During the Kickoff the Squad members...
 - Will introduce themselves, their goal, and reason for joining the Squad.
 - Clarify communication expectations with one another
- Before you end the meeting, decide on a Hot Topic for the following week
 - Browse the Hot Topic options in the Support Center
 - Example: Setting Boundaries at Work
 - The Squad Mod is responsible for updating the Squad curriculum with the details for the Hot Topic.



The Hot Topic Meeting

Before the second Squad meeting

- The Mod confirms the Hot Topic selection in the Group Conversation.
- The Mod provides the link to the Hot Topic Setting Boundaries at Work
 to make it easy for the Squad to prepare for the discussion.

During their meeting:

- Mods make sure each Squad member shares lessons learned and has a chance to speak about their own experiences with setting boundaries
- During the last 10 minutes of the discussion, the Mod has the Squad focus on outlining specific changes everyone could make in their professional lives to help with setting boundaries successfully

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

How the Squad Prepped for their Hot Seats

- The Mod always confirms the upcoming Hot Seat at the end of every meeting and in the Group Conversation
- A few days before a member's scheduled Hot Seat, they complete the Hot Seat Worksheet.
- Next, the Hot Seater summarizes their main goal/questions in the Group Conversation.
 They complete this ~24 hours in advance of their Hot Seat.
- The rest of the Squad reads the summary before the upcoming meeting.


Can we workshop my resume? I feel like I could get a much better job (and make more money) if I knew how to sell myself better to a new employer.

What are some skills that you know you need to accomplish this goal? What might you do to close the skills gap?





FAQ's

How does the Hot Seat schedule get created?

 Our website automatically generates a schedule when we activate your Squad.

Can Hot Seat dates be swapped?

 Absolutely! You are able to make edits - any change requests can be discussed at a Squad meeting or in the Group Conversation

How do I learn from other people's Hot Seats?

- Be an active listener during all Hot Seats
- Take notes on advice that resonates with you even if that advice isn't directed towards you
- Come to every Squad meeting with an open mind



Hot Seat Etiquette

Your presence is by far the best gift you can give someone in your life, and your Squad is no exception.

The success of the Squads program is directly correlated to the attendance and engagement from all members of the Squad.

This is a program that has impacted 15,000+ women over the last 6 years ... our data supports that attendance and active listening are the most important factors in helping participants feel fulfilled by the experience.

It's critical you make every effort to attend each member's Hot Seat, and engage with each one as if it were your own Hot Seat.

Just the simple act of showing up will go a long way in building long last relationships.



Communicate schedule conflicts in advance

In our sample Rising Leader Squad, a couple of members communicated their schedule changes and conflicts before the Kickoff meeting:

- Leia sent a message using the Group Conversation tool to the Squad: "I will be out of the galaxy during our Squad meeting on April 21st! Will be back the following meeting!"
- Mindy also sent a message to the group: "A patient of mine is running late, so I will be
 late or miss today's Squad meeting, but will look at the notes to stay in the know!"

Real life FAQs for Mods

- What happens if someone misses a meeting and forgets to send a message?
 - Reach out 1:1 after the meeting to see what happened
- What happens if I need to miss a meeting? Can I ask someone else to be the Mod for that day?
 - Yes! We encourage you to ask for a substitute upfront so that everyone is clear on what they need to do to help the Squad move forward.



Retrospective

All good things must come to an end! This is the last official meeting for your Squad!

- This is the perfect time to reflect on the past 11 weeks, sharing what you've gained from the Squad experience.
- Many Squads continue to meet after the conclusion of the 12 meetings. You can choose to meet monthly, bi-monthly, once a quarter...whatever cadence makes most sense to the members in your Squad.
